Alliance Hails U.S.-Mexico Cross-Border Trucking Agreement *Agreement Dramatically Reduces Punitive Tariffs on U.S. Exports to Mexico*

July 6, 2011/Washington, DC: The Alliance to Keep U.S. Jobs ("Alliance"), a coalition of more than 170 U.S. industry and agriculture organizations, applauds today's signing of an agreement between the United States and Mexico to reinstate a cross-border trucking pilot program, immediately eliminating 50% of retaliatory tariffs on \$2.4 billion worth of U.S. manufactured and agricultural exports.

Nearly every state in America has been impacted by these tariffs, and will continue to be impacted until the cross-border trucking program begins. We urge the Administration to implement the program as quickly as possible, allowing the remaining 50% of the tariff to be suspended.

The Alliance urges the support of the U.S. Congress for the resolution of this long-standing dispute, and will work actively to oppose any legislative roadblocks to implementation of the agreement.
